

## **Biography, Professor An Sonjae (Brother Anthony)**

Brother Anthony was born in 1942 in England and completed his studies in the University of Oxford before becoming a member of the Community of Taizé (France) in 1969. Since 1980, he has been living in Korea and teaching English literature at Sogang University, where he is now an Emeritus Professor. He is also Chair-Professor in the International Creative Writing Center of Dankook University. From January 2011 until the end of 2020 he was President of the Royal Asiatic Society Korea Branch, he is now its President Emeritus.

He was naturalized as a Korean citizen in 1994 with the Korean name An Sonjae.

During his time at Sogang University he served as English Department Chairman 1992 – 1994, was in charge of the British & American Cultures Major from July 2000 - 2003, and was again Chair of the English Department from May 2001 until July 2003. He served as President of the Medieval and Early Modern English Studies Association of Korea 1998-2000.

He has published over 50 volumes of English translations of modern Korean literature, mainly poetry.

He has received the Korea Times Translation Award, the Daesan Translation Award, the Korean Republic's Literary Award (Translation) and the Korean PEN Translation Award for his work. He took Korean citizenship in 1994 and An Seon-Jae is his official Korean name. He received the Korean government's 문화훈장 Award of Merit, Jade Crown class, in October 2008 for his work in promoting knowledge of Korean literature in the world. He was awarded an honorary MBE by Queen Elizabeth in December 2015 for contributions to Korean-British relations,
