And there is also a festival for Manhakdo, who has started studying late. They learn writing and enjoy sports day at mock school. The festival's background music sends out retro songs that were popular at the time. Finally, an annual contest will be held to commemorate Retro Day. Adolescents and all-academic students will be judged in different categories, and winners will be provided with LP editions of the singers they want, retro snack boxes and prize money. And their writing will be published in the Hall of Fame of "Retro Day Writing Contest."

Finally, elementary, middle and high school programs will be promoted. It is a program and festival that makes the trend-leading MZ generation interested in retro. Each school will hold events based on retrorelated explanation broadcasts and booth experiences. On this day, they wear old school uniforms, make sugar honeycomb toffee, and solve history quizzes.
